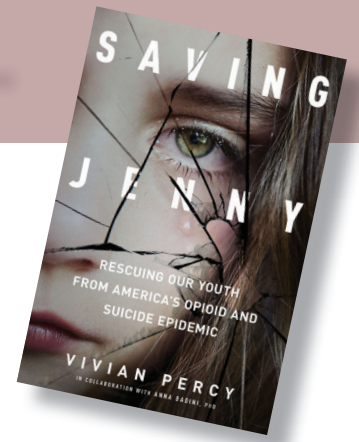


Sample interview questions for **Vivian Percy, Esq., (a nom de plume)**

9. What health care, political, socio-economic, educational, and religious denominational reforms and solutions do you propose for the drug addiction/suicide epidemic?
